

## 2010 Pilot One Scale Competition

We are pleased to add the Pilot One scale competition to this year's EFX.

Hobby Lobby has graciously offered up the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes for this event. This will be held on Saturday in the main (large) flight box with plenty of airspace.

The rules are simple and it must be a model of an actual full scale aircraft.

1) Aircraft must be 48" span or less, 20oz AUW or less and battery must be 2200 mAh or less.

2) Helis must have a main blade length of 350mm or less, 30oz AUW or less and battery of 2200mAh or less.

3) You flight must include realistic taxi and take off, scale climb, optional scale maneuver of your choice, judges fly by (scale speed of your choice), approach and landing. Taxi in is not judged.

100 total points (50 points static, judged prior to flight competition and 50 points flight routine). Modified ARFs will be allowed but must include a minimum of 2 additions to stock kit. Modified ARFs will receive a 5% static score deduction. Judges will account for craftsmanship during the static portion.

Mr. Tim Lime will be the point of contact Saturday morning for scale entrants.

We will limit the number of entrants to 12. Please send your intention to compete and a photo (if available) to [efexpo@aol.com](mailto:efexpo@aol.com) with "Pilot One Scale Competition" in the subject line please.

Prizes: First Place- 1/6 scale PA-12, Second Place- 1/8 Scale Waco and 3rd Place is a 1/8 Scale Stinson!
